We must give Him all the praise and glory for He has truly blessed us. Our family is a family of strength. We are founded on faith, love, and kept together by God.

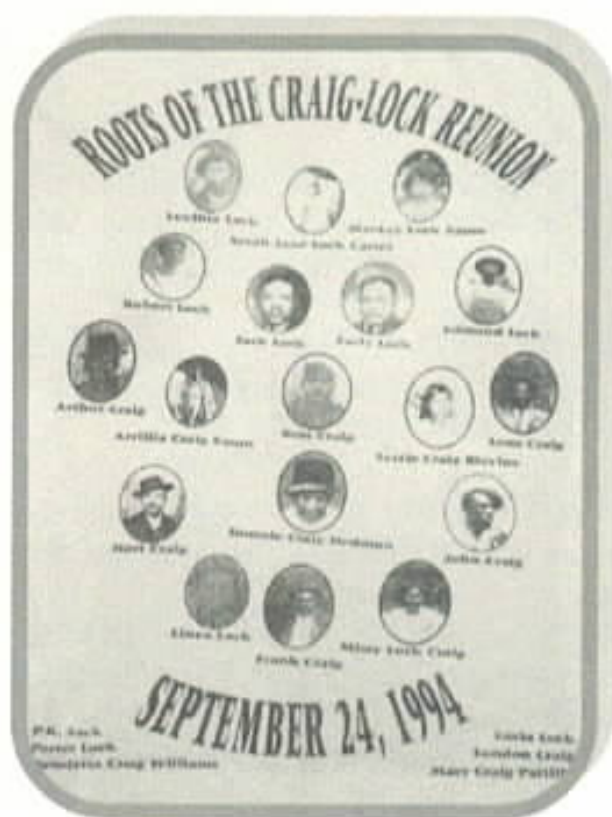

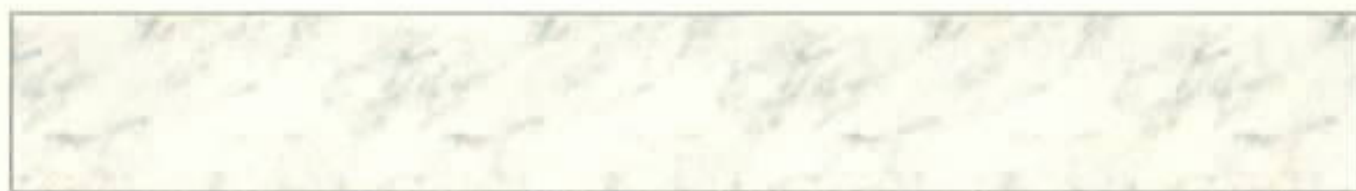
